
WORDS TO KNOW!



Loyalists: Americans who opposed independence from England.

Revolution: A sudden change in government that usually begins with a rebellion.

Independence: Self-rule; not being controlled by another country or person.

Continental Congress: A government made up of representatives from each of the 13 colonies that made decisions during the Revolutionary War including the decision to declare independence.

Boycott: To refuse to buy or use in order to bring about change.

Treason: Betrayal of your country.

Tyranny: A government where a single ruler, like a queen or a king, has and abuses total power.
