





Words to Know!


 **Yuletide log:** A European Christmas tradition involving a large log placed in a fireplace as the foundation of the fire.


 **Kinara:** A Swahili word meaning candle holder. The Kinara holds 7 candles for Kwanzaa that represent the Seven Principles.

 **Dreidel:** Dreidel is a traditional Hanukkah game featuring a four sided top.

 **Advent:** Advent is the season of preparation for the Nativity of Christ prior to Christmas.

 **Nguza Saba:** The Seven Principles of Kwanzaa including Unity, Self-Determination, Responsibility, Cooperative Economics, Purpose, Creativity, and Faith.

 **Menorah:** A candlestick holder that holds multiple candles. During Hanukkah, one candle is lit for each of the 8 nights, with an extra candle being used to light the others.

 **Winter Solstice:** Occuring on 12/21/22 -The first day of winter and the shortest day of the year.
