WORDS TO KNOW!



Underground Railroad: A network of people and hideouts slaves used to escape to the North.



Freedom Seeker: A slave seeking freedom in the North. They may also be referred to as a fugitive slave or runaway slave.



Station: A hiding place for freedom seekers on the Underground Railroad.



Stationmaster: The person in charge of the station.



Conductor: Guides on the Underground Railroad who helped guide slaves from station to station.



Quaker: A member of the Religious Society of Friends. Quakers were a key part in the Underground Railroad because they believed in peace and abolition.



Abolitionist: A person who believed in ending slavery.
